1. O-BIC RECRUITS 34 OVERSEAS COMPANIES TO OSAKA IN FY2023 - WELL UP ON FY2022

The Osaka Business and Investment Center (O-BIC) announced on May 30, 2024, that it had recruited some 34 overseas companies to Osaka in FY2023, a significant increase over the previous year in the run-up to the 2025 World Expo in Osaka.

The largest number of investments came from China with 13, followed by the Republic of Korea with 11, and Taiwan, the USA, and the UAE

2. WHAT'S IN STORE THIS YEAR FOR THE CHINA-JAPAN BUSINESS PROMOTION PLATFORM?

The China-Japan Business Promotion Platform, which was launched in June 2023 as an expansion of the China

Business Support Office, is poised for a very active year. The platform team look forward to providing

information to platform subscribers, providing advisory services regarding doing business in China, and

organizing tours and other activities as a means of generating business opportunities.

Highlights of the year so far include a business delegation to Shenyang and Dalian on 22-26 April, 2024.

Participants met with local movers and shakers, and explored business opportunities through visits to local

companies. Meanwhile, on April 22, 2024, we hosted a seminar on China's economic outlook by Long Ke,

senior fellow at the Tokyo Foundation for Policy Research, which attracted an audience of 110.

4. ASEAN-JAPAN BUSINESS PROMOTION PLATFORM NEWS

The OCCI, in partnership with the Vietnamese Consulate-General in Osaka, held a business networking event on May 17, 2024, to coincide with a visit to Osaka by the Deputy Chairman of the Ho Chi Minh City People's Committee. The event was attended by some 50 Vietnamese companies and more than 100 local attendees, and generated lively discussion aimed at collaboration between the two nations.

On May 20, 2024, we held a seminar jointly with the Thai Consulate-General in Osaka. The audience heard from several leading Thai lawyers about the local investment environment, Thailand's initiatives towards carbon neutrality, and the latest developments in ESG. Attendees had many questions for the speakers, which indicates that there is a keen interest in doing business in Thailand.

5. OCCI SURVEY SHOWS CHALLENGES FACED BY SMES

Dealing with labor shortages is the biggest challenge faced by SMEs according to a survey of SMEs by the OCCI. Some 58.3% of respondents chose investment in manpower saving, securing personnel, preventing turnover, etc. (i.e., labor shortages) as the biggest headache.

Elsewhere, the most common response (32.8%) to a question about whether companies were able to pass on the rising labor costs to customers was a resounding no, indicating high demand for a system that would enable businesses to reflect cost increases in their prices.

Other concerns were also raised: regarding barriers to investment in labor-saving technologies, 44.0% of respondents pointed to a lack of clarity surrounding cost-effectiveness, while 45.6% said that language problems in day-to-day communication were the biggest challenge when working with foreign personnel.
