· New Osaka Metro Station Opens at Expo Venue

Public transport access to the 2025 World Expo venue is improving apace

in the run-up to the expo's grand opening just three months away with the

extension of the Osaka Metro Chuo Line from Cosmosquare Stn. to a new station, Yumeshima, close to the expo venue.

The new station was formally opened on January 18, 2025, with a ceremony attended by some 230 people, including Osaka Governor Hirofumi Yoshimura and Osaka Mayor Hideyuki Yokoyama.

• OCCI Women's Assembly to Host Discussion at 2025 World Expo Women's Pavilion The OCCI

Women's Assembly plans to hold a discussion event at the 2025 World Expo Women's Pavilion this April aimed at further promoting the equal participation of women worldwide in society as business proprietors and


• One Stop Shop Offers Assistance for Expo Participants

2. OCCI TO LAUNCH STUDY GROUP TO HELP LOCAL BUSINESSES DO BUSINESS WITH EMERGING NATIONS
The OCCI will launch an Emerging Nations Business Study Group on February 1, 2025.
The group will function not only as a forum for up-to-date, region-specific, theme-specific information on
emerging countries, but will also hold inspections tours and assist with business meetings and networking
events with companies in those regions.
The high level of interest among the corporate community in doing business with these countries and regions
was illustrated by the pre-launch Africa Business Workshop held in December 2024, which attracted some 200
people. The OCCI is currently planning similar events with a focus on other regions, such as Southwest Asia.
Emerging nations, including the so-called "Global South," such as Southwest Asia, Africa, the Middle East, and
Central and South America, are growing rapidly thanks to their young populations and lively business markets.
The Japanese community recognizes that these regions are not only important business destinations but also

a potential source of workers for Japanese companies starved by labor shortages.

GIF ASEAN-Japan Event Sparks Corporations' Interest in Startups The OCCI held another GIF ASEAN-Japan event, this time on January 17, 2025, providing an online forum for startups from Japan and the ASEAN region to showcase their technologies and services, and talk about the kinds of international collaborations they are looking for. The event, which was held as part of the ASEAN-Japan Business Promotion Platform, attracted a total of 47 participants. The event attracted 90 people from companies in Japan and the ASEAN region.

GIF ASEAN-Japan sought to promote international business development and multilateral cooperation through a live pitch session featuring startups carefully selected by ASEAN-Japan Business Promotion Platform constituents, including the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry, the Singapore Business Federation, the Thai Chamber of Commerce, the Vietnam Chamber of Commerce and Industry, and the OCCI.

The audience heard from five startups, each with unique technologies in fields such as green healthcare, and each presentation was followed by a Q&A and opinion exchange with the audience. Already, several companies have expressed a desire to contact the presenting startups for further talks.

• GIF Osaka Challenge Participants Exhibit at CES, One of the World's Largest Trade Shows

The OCCI led a team of 30 Japanese businesses to exhibit in the Japan Tech booth at the CES, one of the
world's largest trade shows, in Las Vegas from January 7 to 10, 2025.
The booth and its exhibiting businesses were not only a fine advertisement for the 2025 World Expo in Osaka,
but also served to promote exhibiting at CES through online "inspection tours" held in-booth, using live, real
time video feeds. A total of 77 representatives from Japanese companies and related organizations participated
in the online CES tour.
This year's CES was a huge affair, with participants from more than 150 countries and regions worldwide
attracting some 140,000 visitors, a much larger audience than last year. The Japan Tech booth attracted people
from throughout the corporate and media landscape, and exhibitors reported promising contact with major
companies and potential for more substantial meetings.
Japan Tech, a joint effort by the OCCI and Creative Vision, has been a fixture of CES since 2019.


