1. AJB PLATFORM: EXPO 2025 SPECIAL SYMPOSIUM

The OCCI will host a symposium on April 21, 2025, with the heads of the chambers of commerce and industry and other business leaders from its partner nations in the AJB Platform. The symposium is designed to harness the momentum of the upcoming 2025 World Expo to explore

new methods of inter-regional co-creation and problem solving with the aim of strengthening economic relations between Japan and the ASEAN region. Following an opening address by OCCI Chairperson Shingo Torii and video messages from the ASEAN Secretary General and others, the audience will hear from the heads of the AJB Platform's six constituent chambers on their efforts to deepen sustainable economic relations between Japan and the ASEAN region.

The scheduled speakers include Kunihiko Hirabayashi, secretary general of the ASEAN-Japan Centre, who will deliver a special lecture, followed by keynote speeches by prominent business executives from around the

ASEAN region.

There will also be a panel discussion comprising Michael Henssler, chief operating officer of Centara Hotels & Resorts, which operates a chain of hotels in and around Thailand; a representative from the World Association of Overseas Japanese Entrepreneurs; and "green business" company. The discussion will focus on the business potential of co-creation between Japanese and ASEAN partners.

The venue will also feature booths showcasing Japanese and ASEAN chambers of commerce, as well as companies from the ASEAN region, providing an ideal opportunity for interaction between Japanese and ASEAN enterprises. Admission is free, capacity is 500. Sign up to attend here:

GLOBAL BUYERS: UK & EU EDITIONS - EXPANDING OSAKA-EUROPE TRADE The latest edition of Global Buyers, the OCCI's virtual "meet the buyers" initiative, will be held on March 4 and 5, 2025, this time focusing on the UK. Dubbed "Discover New Products from the UK," the online event will bring together British exporters and Osaka-based companies looking to source new and original food products, general merchandise, and fashions. The Global Buyers initiative is just one of the OCCI's efforts to promote import/export trade by helping Japanese companies find suppliers and buyers. Organizers are confident of an increase in interest in overseas goods among Osaka consumers in the run-up to the 2025 World Expo, and put out a call for UK companies hoping to forge sales channels in Japan. A further Global Buyers event will be held on March 25-27, 2025, this time focusing on European companies

looking to source Japanese food and beverages. The online event will be an excellent opportunity for Japanese

Osaka Online Tour & Investment Seminar Showcases Osaka as a Great Place to Live and Do Business
The Osaka Business and Investment Center (O-BIC) hosted an Osaka Online Tour & Investment Seminar on
February 26th, 2025, for overseas businesspeople. The event showed attendees around a variety of locations and
facilities to demonstrate just why Osaka is such a great place to live and do business. Destinations included The Osaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry

locations such as Grand Green, a new innovation hub located next door to Osaka Station (western Japan's largest railway nexus), and an online tour of Futrworks, a co-working space that brings together startups and digital nomads from throughout Japan and around the world. There were also talks on procedural matters, such as how to set up a company in Japan and obtain visas.

Feedback was very positive, with participants commenting that the seminar helped them understand the process of expanding into Osaka in the run-up to the 2025 World Expo.
